- Treasurer's Report
 - Jayme Thomas presents report. Balance of checking as of January 14, 2019 is \$17,036.44.
 Balance of Savings as of January 14, 2019 is \$3,720.35.
 - Laura Heymann motions to approve as read, Al Critz seconds. Treasurer's report approved.
- Big Sam Update by Principal Benavides
 - o Thanks Alumni for all the support of Sam and the impact on teachers and students is felt
 - Mid point through the year, projected to have 3,700 students which is the largest in the district
 - Actively visiting feeder schools to promote SHHS
 - o Soccer season just started and half way through basketball season
