- Darla Peznell: Welcome and Call to Order at 7:02pm
- Darla Peznell: Moment of Silence/Pledge of Allegiance
- Erica Garcia: Minutes
 - Melynda Merrifield moves to accept June minutes as read; Jayme Thomas seconds; motion approved.
- Nicia Harrison: Treasurer's Report
 - Judy Thomas moves to accept June treasurer's report as read; Mike Mullen seconds; motion approved.
 - Al Critz moves to accept July treasurer's report as read; David Inman seconds; motion approved.
- Darla Peznell
 - Reminder about the SLAM Fest: back to school festival that raises funds and school supplies. Festival on September 13, 2016 at SHHS. Admission is \$3 per adult, \$1 per child.
 - President recaps the Board Installation and thanks Kylie Hill and Sheila Young for their service.
 - o Official appointment for Donations Coordinators is announced. Jayme Thomas and Judy Thomas will be both be coordinators for the 2016-2017 school year.
 - Presentation to Mr. Benavides for \$3,000 for his SHHS Principal's Discretionary Fund. This fund helps students who have potential and need support. It helps athletes, band members, students attending academic competitions, etc.

Mr. Benavides

- o Back to school:
 - SHHS is ready to start the school year full-staffed with the exception of two
 positions that are in the works. This is the first time in four years that the
 school will be 100% staffed at the start of a school year.
 - New positions/hires include new AP and new drop-off prevention specialist for freshman.
 - 39 new staff members, 11 of which are brand-new teachers
- o The official accountability report will be released August 12, 2016.
- o This year's focus for SHHS is on literacy. (In the words of Mr. B, it's about "progress, not perfection.")
- o 2016 Senior Class was roughly 700-720 students, with 33 summer grads.
- Facilities:
 - Construction has been approved on 9th Grade Center.
 - MAC will be finished in September.
 - One-way drop off/pick up has been approved by the city (West to East

on Sam Houston Drive.)

- All parking will be on east lot ("dollar lot").
- o Students love the new Band Director! Ms. Sanchez is in charge of Bell Guard.
