- Welcome and Call to Order was at 7:10pm, followed by Pledge of Allegiance and Moment of Silence.
- Erica Garcia announced that June Minutes were posted online. Mike Mullen motioned to accept the minutes as posted; motion was seconded; motion approved.
- Jayme Thomas read June Treasurer's Report. Nicia Dibben motioned to accept the report as read; motion was seconded; motion approved.
- Secretary Updates Erica Garcia
 - Back to School Breakfast Recap
 - The annual breakfast was held on August 8, 2019 and was a great event! The entire breakfast was organized in about 3 weeks.
 - A quick debriefing was held after the event, and the feedback was posted to the Staff Appreciation planning group on Facebook.
 - Changes included having barbacoa, pan dulce, sausage biscuits, individual yogurts, and more fruit. All of these were big hits with the faculty and staff.
 - Total in-kind amount totaled approximately \$802 as of meeting date, with the expectation to be higher after all amounts were provided by donors.
 - The new Sam Houston HS Principal, Juan Villarreal, was impressed and grateful for this event.
 - Big thank you to all volunteers and donors!
 - AISD Volunteer Approvals
 - Every year, AISD requires individuals interested in volunteering at the schools to submit an application and be approved.

- Treasurer Updates Jayme Thomas
 - o 2019-20 Proposed Budget
 - Provided and reviewed actual amounts spent in 2018-19 year.
 - Reviewed proposed categories for 2019-20 budget, which would replace

- specific line items and provide broader coverage for expenses.
- Laura Heymann advised that in preparing the proposed budget, the Budget Committee discussed and reviewed expenses over the last 5-6 years. There are currently 5 grants the Board plans to apply for. Overall, the need at Sam Houston HS is great but will continue to fluctuate. Any funds raised will help the school. Also, Laura mentioned that New Day was providing food for FIT students to take home, and that help is expected to continue.
- Jayme Thomas provided reminder that Alumni Support Applications (ASAs) are available for Sam Houston HS faculty and staff.
- Claudia Perkins mentioned that she is on Arlington Urban Ministries' Board, and the organization is a great resource for last-minute student needs.
- Erica Garcia answered questions regarding the Starry Night Prom. The organization's board members stepped down last year with no replacements announced. Due to this issue, AISD held a Prom for all skills students.
- Nicia Dibben motioned to approve 2019-20 proposed budget; motion was seconded; motion approved.

 - Based on a suggestion from different alums, the Board explored options on polo shirts.

 - The goal is to provide a t-shirt to every Sam Houston student as well. The current plan is to provide t-shirts in rounds, starting with the Senior Class. As fundraising money comes into the organization, then additional t-shirts will be printed for the Junior, Sophomore, and Freshmen.
