- Welcome and Call to Order was at 7:06pm, followed by Moment of Silence and Pledge of Allegiance.
- Erica Garcia read August Minutes. Jayme Thomas moved to accept the minutes as read; motion was second; motion approved.
- Jayme Thomas read August Treasurer's Report. Melynda Merrifield moved to accept the report as read; motion was second; motion approved.
- Mr. Benavides
 - Had correction to the graduation rate. The correct rate is 82.4%.
 - o There are 3,693 students enrolled this year, which is the highest number in AISD.
 - o For the 1st time in 7 years Mr. B has worked there, SHHS is 100% staffed.
 - o They will have a busy fall season with sports.
 - Operation Graduation Volunteers go out to talk to students in neighborhood that have not enrolled back in school. The volunteers encourage them to come back to school to graduate. Event will be Saturday, 9/15/18. Volunteers would meet at SHHS at 8:30am.

 - o 9/27 22nd Annual Ken Gaston Invitation @ Joe Pool Lake
 - This is a fundraiser for Boys and Girls Cross Country teams.
 - The event keeps growing and is now up to 99 schools.
 - Students are coming as far as College Station and Lufkin.
 - Volunteers are needed from 6am to about noon.
