Defining goals. Where do we begin? Some people new to the alumni association would like to expand the clubs efforts by helping out more than two scholarship recipients at the end of the year. After the last SHHS Alumni Association meeting, it became clear that the school needs help with feeding football players, band, drill team, cheerleaders, coaches, etc before games. Kids are not eating after school and prior to games. Also, the Long Tall Texan needs stilts. The drill team and cheerleaders may need help with uniforms. The bell guards need white hats. How should we get these things and stay within UIL guidelines?

What is the non-profit status of Alumni Assoc? They are currently using the Band Booster Club's 501(c)3 status and filtering all monies through that avenue. This is not an acceptable way of handling things if we are going to try to raise LARGE amounts of money in the future. Who is filing the taxes for the Band Booster Club? No one was sure.

Do we want to combine our efforts or be separate entities? We took a vote and the majority decided to stay as one big group under the Alumni Association umbrella of activity. It was stressed by Becky Phillips, and then by Bob Callas that we all need to work together and be open-minded as new ideas and new members become active. Most everyone agreed this can be a very good thing for the kids of SHHS.

Technology Chairperson – voted in was Brenda Allen. Her job is to get all social media (IE: Facebook, the alumni website, etc) up to date with the happenings of the alumni association.

Committee Chairperson – Voted in was Becky Phillips. She will preside over all committees, making sure there is progress and activity in each one until goals are met. She will give an update on each committee at all alumni meetings IF the committee chair over the individual committee is not in attendance.

PTA Liaison – Voted in was Darla Peznell. SHHS has not had a PTA in over 8 years. There is no record of one anywhere in the PTA of Texas files. Darla is working with an SHHS parent to get one recreated. Darla will report back to the Alumni Association on how we can join and get the word out about helping the
